- Proof of USJF, USJA, or USJI registration required.

### **REFEREE & OFFICIALS:**

- All Referees & Table Officials are asked to attend the meeting at 8:30AM
- All Referees will conform to the proper IJF dress code with the following exceptions:
  - o A white polo shirt with dark gray slacks & black socks will be required.

## **METHOD OF ELIMINATION:**

- A True Double elimination system will be used.
- Round Robin & points may be used in divisions with 4 or less contestants.

#### **CONTEST RULES:**

- All Current IJF Contest Rules will apply with the following modifications:
  - o The CARE system will be utilized.
  - Pre-2014 gi requirements will apply for non-black belt divisions.
  - o Chokes (shime-waza) are only allowed for competitors 13-years of age & older.
  - Arm locks (kansetsu-waza) are allowed <u>ONLY</u> in the Black Belt division (Must be 15-years of age or older). Arm locks in the Brown Belt division will NOT be permitted.
  - Drop Knee Seoi Nage will <u>ONLY</u> be permitted in divisions of 13-years of age or older (not allowed for ages 12 or younger).
  - o Competitors who elect to move up a division are subject to the rules of that division.
- Footwear is <u>required</u> at all times when not on the competition area (tatami mats).
- Tournament Director reserves the right to make any changes that will be in the best interest and safety of the competitors.

### **UNIFORMS:**

- The designated "Blue" contestant may wear a blue judo gi with their grade belt or a white judo gi with a blue belt.
- The "White" contestant will wear a white judo gi and a white belt. The white contestant may wear their grade belt if the blue contestant wears a blue judo gi.
- Blue and white belts will be provided.

## **AGE & WEIGHT DIVISIONS:**

- All contestants will be grouped in divisions according to their age, weight and rank.
- Excessive weight players may be moved up an age division with the consent of their coach and parents.
- Novice Divisions (yellow and lower) will be formed if enough contestants qualify to form a bracket (Junior/Intermediate Divisions).
- All contestants must compete in their own age/weight division prior to competing in a higher division.
- Senior Divisions: Brown belt division players must be 3<sup>rd</sup> kyu rank or higher.
- Black belt division players must be 2<sup>nd</sup> kyu rank or higher.
